Ladies – smart black outfits:

- Black dress is preferable - length can be anything from just above the knee to a maxi length, but just not a full-on evening dress or ballgown!
- Black jacket if you want to wear one.
- Black skirts or smart black trousers (no jeans or leggings) are also fine with a black top/blouse
- Smart black shoes (or smart boots) . Smart sandals allowed for June/July gigs. No scruffy footwear allowed.
- No tights needed for any of the gigs in June/July. They will be needed for the Sept gig.
- Jewellery of choice (black, silver, gold, sparkly, blue – not other colours)

With a splash of **PLAIN ROYAL BLUE ACCESSORY** (scarf/pashmina, jewellery, brooch for eg.)

- **Please note: no blue clothes (jackets, cardigans, jumpers, tops, skirts, dresses, or shoes etc) – not navy, not dotty – plain royal blue only.**

Note: For the more formal Autumn/Xmas gigs in 2024 and similar events going forward, Ladies will be expected to wear smart black evening attire – so long dresses(midi/maxi), or long black skirts with a smart black top, or evening trouser suit. Black will be the main colour with either just gold/silver/sparkly jewellery or occasionally with the addition of red or royal blue accessories. The additional colour will be given out in advance of the individual event.

Men – black trousers and black jacket (if you want), NO TIE, royal blue long sleeved shirts

- black trousers (not jeans), black belt if wearing one.
- black jacket if you want to wear one
- black socks and smart black shoes (no trainers)

Note: For the more formal Autumn/Xmas gigs in 2024 and similar events going forward, Men will be expected to wear black evening attire – so DJs – but with a white evening shirt. Black and white will be the main colours with either just a black bow tie, or occasionally a red bow tie. The additional colour will be given out in advance of the individual event.
